

SAT Prep Class

Goal: The goal of this class is to prepare students for successful performance on the SAT General Test on August 25, 2018. This class has both an English and a Mathematics component.

Who: Anyone who has successfully completed Algebra 2 and English 10.

When: Session A – Tuesdays / Thursdays, 10am – 12pm, starting Tuesday 7/31/18 – Thursday 8/23/18
English: 8/7, 8/9, 8/21, 8/23 @ Miller Library (Note: 8/23 will run 2:30pm-4:30pm)
Math: 7/31, 8/2, 8/14, 8/16 @ Miller Library

Session B – Saturdays 10am – 12:30pm and Sundays 1pm – 3:30pm
starting Saturday 8/4/18 – ending Sunday 8/19/18
English: 8/5, 8/12, 8/19 @ Miller Library
Math: 8/4, 8/11, 8/18 @ Miller Library

Session C – Monday – Thursday, 5pm – 7pm, starting Monday 8/13/18 – Thursday 8/23/18
English: 8/14, 8/16, 8/21, 8/23 @ Miller Library
Math: 8/13, 8/15, 8/20, 8/22 @ Central Library

Where: Differs by session, see above session information

Cost: Session A – \$240 + cost of workbook (see below) for 16 hours of instruction
Session B – \$225 + cost of workbook (see below) for 15 hours of instruction
Session C – \$240 + cost of workbook (see below) for 16 hours of instruction

Materials: *The Official SAT Study Guide, 2018 Edition* (ISBN-13: 978-1457309281) workbook, pencils, eraser, and calculator.

Expectations:

1. Students are expected to complete homework assignments as assigned. Students will have an assignment in preparation for the first class.
2. Students are expected to arrive on time and stay for the entire duration of class.
3. Students are expected to be a present and engaged participant.
